

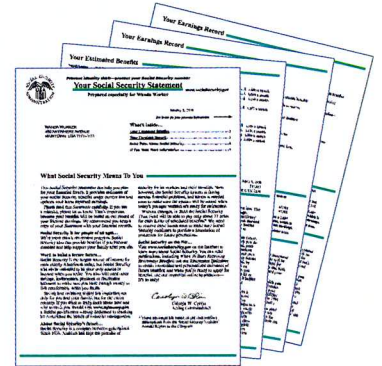
Do you have a personal Social Security website?

At each stage of your life, **my Social Security** is for you. Your personal online **my Social Security** account is a valuable source of information beginning in your working years and continuing throughout the time you receive Social Security benefits.



Your own personal Social Security **"myAccount"** gives you the ability to download your Social Security Statement:

- Get benefit estimates for retirement, disability and survivors
- See your Social Security earning record for retirement benefits and/or medicare benefits

You will need to verify

- Personal information
- Valid email address
- Agreement to the terms of service
- Your Social Security Number
- Age (must be over 18)

It only takes 10 minutes.

* *You can only create an account using your **own personal information and for your own exclusive use**. You cannot create or use an account on behalf of another person, even if you have that person's written permission. You can never share the use of your account with anyone else under any circumstances. Unauthorized use of this service is a misrepresentation of your identity to the federal government and could subject you to criminal or civil penalties, or both.*
